Radnor Memorial Library Director Named

The Board of Trustees of the Memorial Library of Radnor Township appointed Kathleen Colson Mulroy of Ambler, Montgomery County as the new Executive Director of the library, according to Board President George Strimel.

Ms. Mulroy has previously served as director of several college and university libraries in the Philadelphia area, most recently as director of the library at Philadelphia University. She began her career working in public libraries in Kentucky and Ohio and has been a library consultant in Pennsylvania and New Jersey, where she worked at the New Jersey State Library. She is the co-author of *Automating Your Library* (American Library Association, 1994) and has served on state and regional library organizations' boards. She is a Phi Beta Kappa graduate of the University of Kentucky and holds a Master of Library Science from this same institution.

An avid gardener, Ms. Mulroy is excited about the Radnor Library's partnership with Chanticleer and looks forward to reacquainting herself with the Radnor community. "I worked at the Delaware County Library System some years ago and was impressed by the community involvement in and support for the Radnor library. In my discussions with the library board, it is clear this has continued and that the library remains an important part of the community fabric. I look forward to working with the board, the township, the Friends of the Library, and everyone else in Radnor in keeping the library vital and vibrant."

The Board expressed its appreciation to acting library director Dorothy Carlson for her work and dedication to the library over the years and especially during the critical search period.
